Scope of the Board

The Diocesan Commission on Liturgy, Art, and Music (LAMB) assists pastors and parish liturgical committees in providing appropriate liturgical services and environment for worship.

1. No liturgical space, especially a church, oratory, chapel, or shrine, is to be constructed or substantially renovated without the explicit written consent of the diocesan bishop.
2. When seeking to build or significantly renovate any liturgical space, a pastor is obliged to submit the plans for such construction or renovation to the diocesan Liturgy, Art, and Music Board, which in turns makes recommendation to the bishop concerning the matter.
3. Plans must be submitted in two occasions: prior to the finalization of the schematic designs and again upon finalization of the construction documents.
4. The pastor must consult with the diocesan Liturgy, Art, and Music Board in developing even preliminary concepts and designs for new liturgical construction and renovation of existing worship space.
